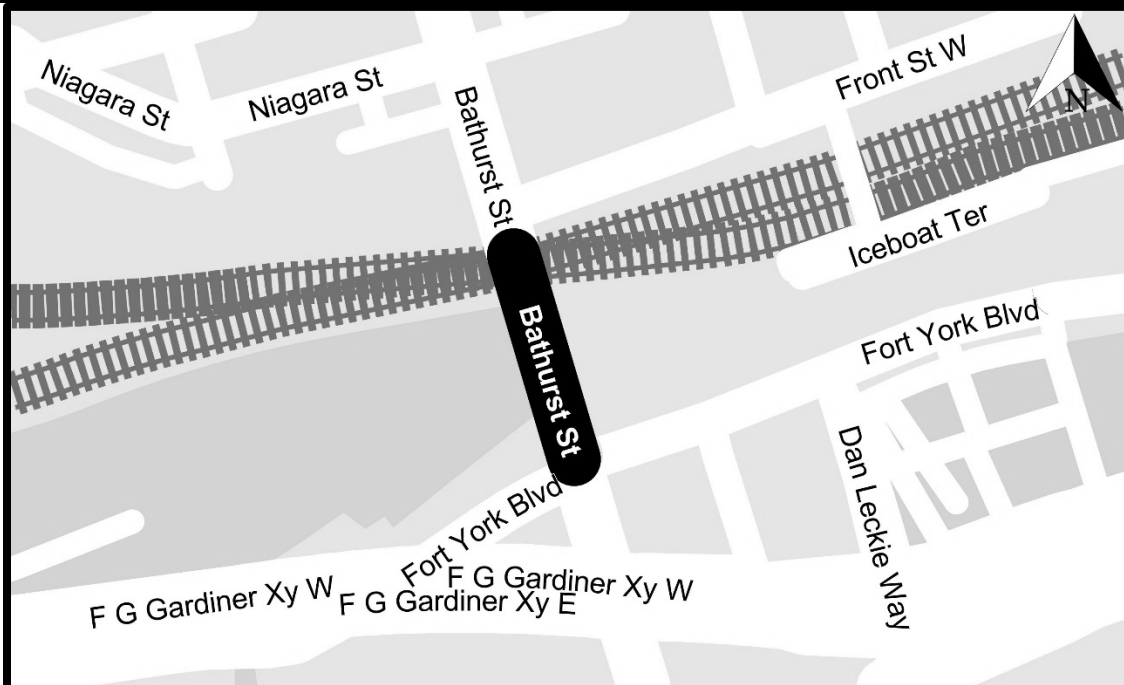

The City of Toronto will rehabilitate the Bathurst Street Bridge south of Front Street and replace the adjoining Fort York Pedestrian Bridge in 2018. The majority of the work is to take place beneath the bridge. This work will ensure that both bridges meet today's standards and remain safe for vehicles and pedestrians in the future.

The project is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Repair and refurbish the existing underside of the Bathurst Street road bridge
- Perform minor repairs to the girders and sidewalks on top of the Bathurst Street road bridge
- Reconstruct the deck and repair the piers of the Fort York Pedestrian Bridge

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area. At least one sidewalk along Bathurst Street will be open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: The majority of the work will be underneath the bridge. Short-term lane closures may be necessary for minor work on the bridge surface.</p>
	<p>Restoration: Areas affected by construction will be restored.</p>
